

Concord Sand Volleyball
Cornhole Rules

'Spin the bag' winner before the first game chooses who will throw first or which side they want to start off on. The other choice goes to the other team. Throw on same side as your teammate. The team not throwing first may choose which side of the board they want. To start the following games team to throw first will alternate.

Games are to 21pts, the winner is determined by the first team that reaches or passes 21pts.

3 points are awarded for a bag that goes through the hole.

1 point is awarded for each bag that lands on the board.

Cancelations count, example: if you have 2 in the hole & 1 on the board (7pts) and the other team has 1 in the hole & 2 on the board (5pts), then your team receives 2pts.

Only one team scores points per throw.

The team that scores will throw first on the following throws.

If no team gets points on a throw, then the team that scored last throws first.

Players alternatively throw 1 bag at a time (4 times).

You may not step in front of the board on your follow through throw.

***** All games end at 25 minutes after the hour no matter the score. If there is a tie the team that got the last point to make it a tie loses.**

***** If you haven't started your 3rd game by the hour then you should probably go to rally scoring where all points count (no cancellations).**

***** It will be the responsibility of both teams to judge when or if they should go to rally scoring in order to finish their games by 25 minutes after the hour.**

***** This should keep games on schedule. Games start at the time given. Show up early to warm up. Your first throws for the first game should be at half past the hour.**

The season is 9 weeks long, 8 weeks of play **plus** 1 night of playoffs.

Prizes for the Recreational Division will be as follows:

1st Place \$80 bar tab, 2nd Place \$60 bar tab, 3rd Place \$40 bar tab

Prizes for the Competitive Division will be as follows:

1st Place \$300, 2nd Place \$200

Each team may carry a maximum of 6 players on their roster.

No one in the competitive division can sub in the recreational division.

A recreational division player can sub in on a competitive team.

In the competitive division only, you can only play on one team.

When you are finished with a game please mark a W or L on the scorecard.

After your 5 game match please initial the scorecard.

You may bring your own bags to play with, we will also have house bags to use.

Games are back to back, please get your drinks before your match starts.
